



TEACHER TRAINING

Terms & Conditions –

Students should have been practicing yoga for 2 years and have a strong practice before they embark on a teacher training course.

Please check the course dates carefully to ensure you are able to attend the entire course.

Fees Include:

- Training and assessment by a qualified Yoga Alliance Professionals UK SYT
- A full manual and other appropriate paperwork
- YAP Teacher Training certificate subject to satisfactory completion of all course work and attendance of a minimum 80% of the course days.

Fees do not include:

Flights, accommodation, transport, parking and subsistence, Insurance (this is available from Yoga Alliance Professionals), Course study texts - Additional private training if required to make up any missed course days.

A £700 non-refundable deposit is required to secure a place on the course, payable at the time of the booking.

The full fee should be paid 28 days before the beginning of the course.

Applications will be offered a place subject to successful interview and will be required to pay the deposit to secure their place on the course.

In the event of the course being oversubscribed, students who have paid their deposit will take priority over those who have not paid their deposit.

We reserve the right to refuse a place to students who have not paid their deposit or full fees by the required date.

All fees, expenses and private sessions must be paid in full before a graduation certificate will be issued.

Students are expected to attend the entire course and should check the course dates before submitting an application.

We understand that from time to time, due to illness or exceptional circumstances, course hours may be missed.

Students should report absences to the Course Director as soon as possible to arrange additional private tuition (payable by the student, currently at £30 per hour).

Students are required to attend a minimum of 80% of the course hours to receive the Yoga Alliance Professionals certificate of training. - Any additional hours required must be completed within 3 calendar months of the final date of the end of the course.

Students are expected to complete to a satisfactory standard all written assignments.

There will be an additional charge of £80 for each assignment that is submitted later than the original deadline, or requires resubmitting.

Students are expected to behave and dress appropriately throughout the course. They should maintain high standards of hygiene and respect other course members, teachers, administrators and members of the public.

We are an inclusive organisation and welcome all.

Cancellation: Course leaders reserve the right to cancel the course at any point. Students will be given a full refund within 28 days of notification.

No claims may be made for any financial or other losses. Students are advised to take out comprehensive insurance if travelling in the unlikely event of the course being cancelled.
